Change in Definition:

Beginning with this issue of the SER, the definition of "non-traditional" student on page 7, column 7 has changed. The old definition counted students as non-traditional if SAT math (SDED #205) was coded 99. The new column, labeled "Non-Traditional Undergraduates," includes those undergraduate students who were 25 or older at time of first matriculation to the institution.
